

Elmwood All Outdoors Show: Big Buck Contest

During the third annual Elmwood All Outdoors Show March 3-4 you can have your trophy buck measured by certified measurers from the Boone and Crockett Club, Pope and Young Club and Illinois Big Buck program. You can also win a prize just for entering.



Cost is \$10 to have a deer measured and displayed. For that you get a two-day pass to our show, which features more than 100 outdoor-related vendors. Deer heads are accepted Thursday, March 1 and Friday, March 2 from 5-7 p.m. and Saturday, March 3 from 9 a.m. to noon. Short-term parking is available for buck drop-off on the east side of the Elmwood High School gymnasium. Antlers do not have to be mounted to be measured. Entries can be picked up after 3 p.m. on Sunday, March 4.

Deer having already been officially measured are welcome. You must bring a copy of your scoresheet and can then enter the show for \$5 per day.

Cost is \$10 to have a deer measured that is not displayed. There is no guarantee deer not displayed will be measured. Only deer displayed are eligible for plaques and prizes.

No shed antlers will be measured.

Measuring is on a first-come, first-served basis and we reserve the right to shut off entries at 100.

Four awards will be given Sunday at 3 p.m. (based on Boone and Crockett standards):

1. Archery (not including crossbows): highest-scoring non-typical
2. Archery (not including crossbows): highest-scoring typical
3. Firearm (includes all weapons): highest-scoring non-typical
4. Firearm (includes are weapons): highest-scoring typical

There is also a random drawing among all entries for various prizes.

All proceeds from the show benefit athletic programs and students of Elmwood High School.
